News and Views

I'm back from two glorious weeks in the New Forest! The cottage was charming, the garden glorious. We had lots of walks, exploring areas of the Forest new to us and re-visiting favourite places from the past. We played scrabble and we read. We met up with old friends who we haven't seen for 30 years and had the two eldest grand-daughters for a sleepover! (If you are ever in the area, I highly recommend the Winchester Science Centre and Planetarium.) It was all just what I needed. And every day I thanked God for the beauty of his amazing creation and all his blessings! And it's good to be back!

This weekend sees the annual summer Foodbank collection at Tesco's. Did you know that the Trussell Trust supports a network of over 420 foodbanks (including our Fosse Foodbank)? It provides a minimum of three days' emergency food and support to people experiencing crisis in the UK. In 2020 the foodbanks supplied 2.5million emergency food parcels – more than half a million of these went to children. (And the numbers are increasing all the time.) Stopping hunger is about more than just food which is why foodbanks offer additional advice and support to tackle the underlying causes of crisis. The Trussell Trust undertakes research to identify the structural issues behind foodbank use and to find solutions; works to raise awareness of the issue of hunger in the UK and campaigns on a national level for long-term change.
