We were challenged to think about how the church needs to change in order to address the requirements of a changing rural culture, while holding onto our foundations. What do we need to let go of so we can invest in new thinking – to embrace a "mixed economy" – different styles of mission? We need to pay "radical" attention to what is happening in our communities in order to respond as kind, caring, loving neighbours. We were encouraged to grow a new worshipping community that would be totally unconnected to anything we are currently doing. We also had an interesting seminar on "forest church" – about rural spirituality and how we can re-engage Christians with our land and seasons – the sacred spaces around us.
