They gave us a tour of their warehouse and explained all the different projects they run, including a furniture project for families who are moved into empty homes; a baby project with everything a new mum and baby will need during their stay in hospital; a toy project for children who have none. They support families with school uniforms. They take emergency items to newly arrived families. They run a World Foods Hub with reduced cost world foods. With just a small team, they are truly amazing!
